## Questions about everyday things

How often do you read the newspaper / watch TV? Three times a week / every day, etc. What time do you get up / go to work? Seven o'clock. / Half past eight. etc. How do you go to work? By bus/train/car, etc.

### Usually/normally (what I do typically)

We say I usually/normally get up at eight o'clock, but today I got up at eight-thirty. [NOT I used to / I'm used to get up at eight o'clock!]
